Now is a Good Time to Evaluate Your Membership!

- 1. As a member of GCREA you have the advantage of participating in an exciting, involved and growing local unit. GCREA meets at a beautiful, spacious facility, Sugarloaf County Club in Duluth. We support several charitable and school related projects. We have lively and informative meetings. Your leadership is excellent with enthusiasm and vision. You pay annual dues one way or the other. There are two options:
- A. ADD membership which means your annual dues are subtracted monthly from you GCPS retirement check at the rate of \$2.09 per month. You sign up one time and then forget about it. Your dues are automatically paid and GCPS sends GCREA a check each month. Easy Peasy!! I am happy to send you the form to fill out to enroll in ADD membership.
- B. Regular Annual membership which means that you pay your dues by check once a year in June. A renewal letter is sent to you with an information update form and a return envelope. You must write a check and mail this in. YOU HAVE TO REMEMBER TO RENEW EACH YEAR.
- c. WE NO LONGER OFFER Lifetime memberships, but we have many Life members. It has become very difficult to keep up with many of our Life members, especially if they have moved away or are deceased. After six years, the \$160 they originally paid no longer supports the activities of GCREA. So, if you are a Life member of more than six years, please consider becoming an ADD member so you continue to support GCREA. Again, I am happy to send you the enrollment form.
- 2. GREA (our state organization) membership Our state organization has a membership of approximately 32,400 members statewide. Membership in the state organization is very important because that is our loudest voice at the Capitol when matters of education and teacher (current and retired) pay and benefits are concerned. The louder our voice the better chance we have of keeping that legislation fair and legislators on our side. Those of us who are already GREA members wear a gold ribbon attached to our GCREA nametag to show our support. If you are not currently a GREA member, please consider joining us. We worked hard for our retirement pay and benefits we need that voice to help us keep what we earned!! I am happy to send you enrollment information.
